This package needs two 2 dependencies:

- the `comfортаa` package
- the `cantarell` package

Once the archive downloaded and extracted, copy texmf stuff:

Windows in `C:\texmf\` with MikTeX or TeXLive

Unix with TeXLive:

- in `~/texmf`, for a single user
- in `/usr/local/share/texmf/`, for all users

Don't forget to update your ls-R database!

MikTeX launch the MikTeX options toolbox

TeXLive launch `texhash` (as root if the theme was installed for all users)

Just call the theme using `\usetheme{Laughlin}` in your preamble

A sample \LaTeX preamble

```
\documentclass{beamer}

\usepackage[american]{babel}
\usepackage[T1]{fontenc}
\usepackage[utf8]{inputenc}

\usetheme{Laughlin}
```

How to use it?

Options

`language=⟨language⟩` to change the labels language in the buttons of the progress bar.
Available languages are english, french, german, italian, portuguese, spanish.

Example

```
% Labels in French  
\usetheme [language=french] {Laughlin}
```

Alternating table row colors

- 1 Add the `[xcolor=table]` option to `\documentclass{beamer}`
- 2 Add the following line to your preamble:

```
\rowcolors{1}{laughlinblue!50}%  
{laughlinblue!30}
```

Syntactic coloration in `lstlisting` environments

```
#include <stdlib.h>
#include <stdio.h>

/* A comment */
int main (int argc, char* argv [])
{
    printf ("Hello_\uworld!");

    return EXIT_SUCCESS;
}
```

Syntactic coloration in `lstlisting` environments

Add the following lines to your preamble:

```
\lstset{%  
  basicstyle=\ttfamily,%  
  keywordstyle=\color{laughlinblue}%  
  \bfseries,%  
  commentstyle=\color{laughlinblue!75}%  
  \itshape,%  
  columns=flexible%  
}
```
